The odd G# note in the melody riff was in my head as I worked on something else. So I walked over to the piano, quickly found it, started adding walk-down bass that changed with each measure... And loved the results that I immediately went down to my home music studio to record the ideas... and the countermelody that I "just played" for the second part's melody. I changed 3 notes and extended the length of a few.... The rest was completely the Holy Spirit's guidance of my fingers as I played; He lets us add our own creative touches! :) Next 2 steps, I needed some sort of foundation music to start during the drum loops I'd quickly found to match each section's mood. Finally, I added a flute counter-melody by "just playing" and did NOT change ANY notes. Thus I finished the basics of the song before adding the enhancements and taking it to my professional studio for recording the live bass.

Song Story. THE LYRICS. Back in 2008, when I was baptized in a pond at the CREATION MUSIC FESTIVAL as the conclusion of years of feeling I'd missed something by "infant baptism"... I prayed 25 music related prayers. #20 was to write songs for God-- and He has Grace-iously so much answered! And I began fervently, frequently praying to serve Him as Jeremiah did, calling people to BELIEVE that **God Doesn't Change and meant what He said** in what many people call the Old Testament, as well as words thru His Son Jesus. AND, I'll admit I also prayed for forgiveness (and still do) if I were being presumptuous to our Great LORD God to pray such. So..... When I finished this music, I prayed for guidance, immediately turned to Jeremiah 3: The words fit the mood Perfectly.

The odd G# note in the melody riff was in my head as I worked on something else. So I walked over to the piano, quickly found it, started adding walk-down bass that changed with each measure... And loved the results that I immediately went down to my home music studio to record the ideas... and the countermelody that I “just played” for the second part's melody. I changed 3 notes and extended the length of a few.... The rest was completely the Holy Spirit's guidance of my fingers as I played; He lets us add our own creative touches! :) Next 2 steps, I needed some sort of foundation music to start during the drum loops I'd quickly found to match each section's mood. Finally, I added a flute counter-melody by “just playing” and did NOT change ANY notes. Thus I finished the basics of the song before adding the enhancements and taking it to my professional studio for recording the live bass.

Song Story. THE LYRICS. Back in 2008, when I was baptized in a pond at the CREATION MUSIC FESTIVAL as the conclusion of years of feeling I'd missed something by “infant baptism”... I prayed 25 music related prayers. #20 was to write songs for God-- and He has Grace-iously so much answered! And I began fervently, frequently praying to serve Him as Jeremiah did, calling people to BELIEVE that

God Doesn't Change and

meant what He said in what many people call the Old Testament, as well as words thru His Son Jesus. AND, I'll admit I also prayed for forgiveness (and still do) if I were being presumptuous to our Great LORD God to pray such. So..... When I finished this music, I prayed for guidance, immediately turned to Jeremiah 3: The words fit the mood Perfectly.

SONG STORY. The Lyrics: Like most people raised in a church, I knew the story of Exodus well; after all, some great actions movies come from God's True Story! But it wasn't until October 2014 that I suddenly realized (1) God's first demands were not for “freedom from work” but that His Children of Israel be allowed to go do the sacrifices the LORD had established years earlier for serving Him; and (2) how often Pharaoh said RIGHT words that SOUNDED repenting, sorrowful for not recognizing God's power. It was not until AFTER Pharaoh had ALREADY decided to reject God with his already-hardened heart that God lets us know the He allowed the process to complete: Like dried out clay that can never be molded into a useful pot.... Like the end of Romans 1: God gives plenty of time for people to see His Truth, to seek and accept Him. But eventually He lets them have what they want: Their evil hearts that refuse to recognize Him as LORD, no matter what their mouths say.

I wrote these lyrics in a night.... but couldn't think of any “good” music. **The Music:** The next April, 6 months later, I was praying that God would give me ideas for some of the great lyrics sets He'd guided to be written in the 25 journals since His songwriting ministry thru me began in March 2008 (see song *THIRD OF DESPAIR & HOPE*). On April 15, I re-found this song. On April 16th, all the track sound loops I “just tried” immediately worked. On April 17th, my studio recorded the song.... and put it on the World Wide Web. GOD'S song: Music in 24 hours.

Song Story. MUSIC: In Hebrew, the pictograph (ancient letter form) of NUN = a fish. Therefore I designed flitting fast movements of the chorus melody, like a tiny fish swimming fast back and forth.

LYRICS: Formatted into a song meter in about 15 minutes on the gym elliptical machine. I made a few changes as I typed... to include the scripture reference more often for this short, simple song.... But I noticed:
