Supporting Scriptures, continued

Verse 2: Mark 9:22-23, a father had begged Jesus to heal his child. 'Jesus said to him, "If you can believe-- ALL things are possible to him who believes." Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, "**Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!**"

Verse 3: John 9 history of Jesus healing the blind man includes His method in Verse 9; Step 1 (NLT): "Then he spit on the ground, made mud with the saliva, and spread the mud over the blind man's eyes."

Verse 4: Line 4d: God gives BOLDNESS to speak: Acts 4:29-31 prayer & history example. James 1:5, "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him." Zechariah 4:6, "This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: 'Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' Says the LORD of hosts."
