Song Story.

THE LYRICS: The Bridge is really short, just a clip of what I had planned, because I "lost my place" in my sheet music as we were recording my vocals. It was very late, so I decided to just stick with the draft vocal until the next studio session. But -- after a week of reviewing the song -- I decided that I LIKED the short, emphatic, pretty sad version. I've found that ANYTIME I make a mistake, I should pray to see if maybe it was actually God's guidance. I've come up with some really cool weird rhythms and songs that way! **THE MUSIC:** I was experimenting in my home studio with circus-style music for the song 'TIGER DOORS" when I came up with this sound that I really liked. The syncopated music didn't fit my draft words for a narrative song based on Frank Stockton's 1882 short story *"The Lady Or The Tiger."* (And it sounds more like baseball game music than circus music!) So, with God's help, I just made up a new song. And, yes, I had been again watching some episodes of **STAR TREK** the original series around the time I titled this!
