**Song Story.** On 27 March 2011, I wrote 3 songs including music into my journal. This one was written as BOLDLY COME TO GOD'S THRONE at the sanctuary piano in minutes and recorded at the studio 2 days later. Three years later, while seeking ways to improve these song gifts from God for His world, I used new skill levels to create a more steady pace. But the words kept going through my mind with the question: Doesn't God in Ephesians' instruction book for His Church also tell us to GO from our walls out into His World to share His Word?
