Song Story.

Intriguingly, exactly when I began as I was typing these lyrics onto this web page, Creflo Dollar began preaching in the sermon that my TV was playing in the background that "NOTHING can be accomplished without the anointing... the anointing removes the burden, the yoke around your neck" (Isaiah 10: 27 referencing blessings that keep yokes from fitting any more).

This song is the direct result of fervent prayers to God for wisdom as I needed to decide whether to accept one of the excellent jobs being offered to me as possible great blessings that would meet many needs.... but that would take 45 hours a week away from my time to serve our Lord developing His great song gifts.
