EBENEEZER:

Name given to the stone which that Samuel set up in commemoration of God's help to the Israelites in their victory over the Philistines at Mizpah that would have been IMPOSSIBLE, had God-Named-Yahweh NOT been on their side to give the victory. (1 Samuel 7:12, Exodus 3:14-15, Isaiah 42:8)

The word EBENEEZER has come to mean a monumental stone – real or a symbol within our heart – that acknowledges and thanks God for His great help that He gave the one raising the stone... Not “magic” but a REMINDER that without God, we are lost.
