Psalm 66:18-20, "If I regard **iniquity <deliberate sin>** in my heart, **The Lord will not hear.** 19 But certainly God **has** heard me; He has attended to the voice of my prayer.

20 Blessed be God, Who has not turned away my prayer, NOR His mercy from me!"

The [Yahweh] echo in the CHORUS refers to the name YHWH God (Jehovah) provided in Exodus 3:14, where God tells His Name, meaning "I AM". Usually pronounced "yaw-way"

VERSE 1

"Crickets from Heaven" we seem to hear as
we cry our prayers to God, heartbroken tears, and

(1) Make a joyful shout to God... (2) Sing out the honor of His name.... (3) Say to God, "How awesome are Your works!" And then REMEMBER: If you will not confess your sins, the LORD will NOT hear you....
