Exodus 3:14, God tells us His Name is YHWH, usually pronounced "Yah-way".

SCRIPTURE BEFORE VERSE 1 & AT END OF Song:

"... [God's people] gathered together.... And they fasted that day, and said there, **'We have sinned against the LORD....** And Samuel [offered God a sacrifice]. Then Samuel cried out to the LORD for Israel, and the LORD answered him....

Now as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel. But the LORD thundered with a loud thunder upon the Philistines that day, and so confused them that they were overcome before Israel....

Then **Samuel took a stone & set it up... and called its name EBENEZER,** saying **'Thus far the LORD has helped us.'** ”

13 So the Philistines were subdued, and they did not come anymore into the territory of Israel. And the hand of the LORD was against the Philistines all the days of Samuel.

– 1st Samuel 7: 6, 9-13, God's pattern for National Victory to this day.

VERSE 1

God's protection has conditions. Depend only on LORD God.

Remember God helps you ONLY if you humbly confess sins to God.

First Samuel 7: 4 to 6. God's protection pattern shown.

Put away dependence on false things. Cry OUT to Him:

CHORUS

First Samuel, Chapter 7: REMEMBER what God's done! Raise YOUR own Ebenezer stone to show to the world that it's the LORD who Saves! For two decades, Israel would NOT repent of sins! **IF**

OUR Nation won't repent, God may withdraw Protection.

VERSE 2

God's protection has conditions. Gather in The LORD's Name.

Do not cease to cry to Yahweh God, Pray that He will save your Nation.

First Samuel 7: 6 to 10. God's protection pattern shown.

Sacrifice by praying for God's Will, and NOT for yours. >> CHORUS
