In Exodus 3:14 and Isaiah 42:8, The LORD God tells us His Name. In Hebrew it is YHWH, often spelled as Yahweh (*pronounced "YAW-WAY"*). In most translations, YHWH is translated into English as LORD – The One Above All.... Zephaniah 3: 17: **YHWH God sings:** "The LORD your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing." >> Hebrew "Rinnah" = **singing** (as in Isaiah 44:23).

Reading 1 (after Verse 2): See also Numbers 14 for God's opinion of our complaints that imply we think He's LYING about all His Goodness & Promises. **Numbers 11: 1**
 "Now when the people complained, it displeased the LORD; for the LORD heard it, and His anger was aroused. So the fire of the LORD burned among them, and consumed some in the outskirts of the camp." **<They were calling God a LIAR who could not or would not deliver them as God had promised... insulted HOLY God.>**

Scripture support: God clearly tells us repeatedly that His Name is YHWH (Yahweh > Isaiah 42:8, Exodus 3: 14-15, usually LORD in Bible.) Psalms 105-107 record the HISTORY of when God SAVED the Israel-ites from slavery in Egypt and all the dangers of the desert,

Reading 2 (after Verse 3): Thru **Psalm 106**, after God lets us know what HE thinks of OUR complaining:

19 They made a calf in Horeb, And worshiped the molded image.
 20 Thus they changed their glory Into the image of an ox that eats grass.
 21 They forgot God their Savior, Who had done great things in Egypt,
 22 Wondrous works in the land of Ham, Awesome things by the Red Sea.
 23 Therefore He said that He would destroy them, HAD NOT Moses His chosen one stood before Him in the breach, To turn away His wrath, lest He destroy them.
 24 Then they despised the pleasant land; **They did not believe His word,**
 25 **But complained** in their tents, < PRIVATE words, God hears also!!! >
 And did not heed the voice of the LORD.

Leviticus 19:1, New KJV And then God lists laws of justice and mercy & right-ness.
 "And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying 'Speak to all the congregation of the children of Israel & say to them: 'YOU shall be **holy**, for **I The LORD** your God **AM** holy'."
