A COMPANION SONG to "Isaiah 42 Bruising & Healing", which is *Movement 2

YHWH GOD: "Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights!

I have put My Spirit upon Him; **He** will bring forth justice to the Gentiles. He will not fail nor be discouraged, Till **He** has established justice in the earth; and the coastlands shall wait for **His** law."

Isaiah 42: 1, 4 Obviously this is NOT about "the nation of Israel" whose job was NOT to bring justice OR to have ownership of "His law"....

VERSE 1

"A bruised reed, He will not break" is God's prophecy, promised to all Jews and the world: Isaiah 42: 3. And "A bruised reed, He will not break" is NOT about grass.... God's description of The Messiah that He's bringing to us. It's God's description of The Messiah He's <u>already</u> brought to us.

Matthew 12: 20 described Him: Kind, loving Jesus brought justice to men. Sent for Gentiles as well as for Jews. Sent by GOD to bring Light to you. Isaiah 42, verses 1 to 9 Through God's gentle One. God's elect one. GOD brought justice and Light to this world, to YOU – so take heart if you're bruised by this world. God cared and promised: Isaiah 42: God BRINGING promised MESSIAH to save you.

VERSE 2

He will open up blind eyes, help set captives free. To those who sit in darkness, Messiah shall bring The Light of GOD's Truth for GOD's glory, The LORD is His name. God shall not give His glory to anyone else, so **Isaiah 42:8** shows Jesus's glory was GOD's, Himself.

John chapter 1 describes Him: Jesus is GOD and Life. First Corinthians 15: verse 6, Death is conquered only by GOD. Isaiah 42: 13 is GOD's word He'll go forth like a man, stirring up passion for His Truth... And He shall prevail. God waited in peace a long time. Then GOD brought Himself here:

Isaiah 42: God BRINGING promised MESSIAH to save you.

1 Corinthians 15: 3-6, "...that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, 5 and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve. 6 After that **He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once**... <many who gladly died rather than deny that they'd seen Jesus, God's son, risen from the dead and walking among them>.
