### SCRIPTURE after verse 2's Chorus.

**John 5:14** Afterward Jesus found in the temple in the Temple the lame man whom he had healed, Jesus said to him, "See, you have been made well. Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you."

**John 6:26**, "Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled."... About 30 verses later, we read in

**John 6:60-1**: "...many of His disciples...said, 'This is a hard saying; who can understand it?' When Jesus knew in Himself that His disciples complained about this, He said to them, 'Does this **offend** you?' **John 6:66**> From that time many of His disciples went back & walked with Him no more."

## VERSE 3

**That** is what the people said – See John 6 .... through Verse 66. He asks YOU, do YOU love parables, **but hate** His warnings on **SIN? Will you Leave?**
