## Song Story: THE LYRICS.

Not too complicated. This was one of my earliest song giftings from God.... back when I truly did not expect Him to give me but a few songs as answers to my by-now-3-years of praying to write songs for Him. So I took an earlier song gift from God, I PRAISE YOU DESPITE, and started working in key verses to help me memorize WHERE to find God's Promises. And God guided me to develop the song for you, **to help YOU remember....**

## SUPPORTING VERSES:

### **Verse 1.**

- PROVERBS 3: 5-7 NKJV. "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths. Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and depart from evil."

**Verse 2.** SECOND TIMOTHY 1: 7 NKJV. "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind."

### **Verse 3.**

- FIRST PETER 1: 6-9 NKJV. "In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, that the genuineness of your faith, [being] much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ, whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see [Him], yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, receiving the end of your faith--the salvation of [your] souls."
- JAMES 1: 3 NIV "Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds..."
- JAMES 1: 12 NKJV "Blessed [is] the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him."

**Verse 4.** The companion song for this verse is DianaDee's **"DAILY VICTORY PRAYER."**

  10. "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might."
  11. "Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. "

  13. "Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand."
  14. "Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness,"
  15. "and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace;"
  16. "above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one."
  17. "And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; "
  18. "praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints--"
