JESUS speaking of **one PROPHECY** of HIMSELF - which religious leaders Feared to answer:

41 While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, saying, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?" They said to Him, "The Son of David." 43 He said to them, "**How then does David in the Spirit call Him 'Lord,'** saying: 44 'The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool"?' 45 If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his Son?" 46 And no one was able to answer Him a word, nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore. – Matthew 22.

From DianaDee: This is rather funny: Jesus stumped the Pharisees with his question about Psalm 110's prophecy... right after verse 15 – when they were plotting to try to figure out how to trick JESUS, when they "plotted how they might entangle Him in His talk." **INSTEAD:** They like licked bullies were the ones who had to slink away. God inspired these words: They did not dare to try to trick Jesus.... "from that day on".... Instead they turned to hiring false witnesses against Jesus... These religious leaders **UNDERSTOOD** Jesus **was** saying that HE was Messiah, the LORD of which David was writing.
