Song Story.

Johnny Kyle, owner of J&T Studio where I record tracks completed in my home studio and prepare them for my final production studio "up north", had a foundation track he'd made called "Fever" that he liked but didn't have any plans before. I loved it, but had no ideas right as I listened. I brought it back to my home studio... and, within the next 48 hours ...

God provided the ideas for alternative melodies and counter melodies. Then, after I completed the new music tracks (trumpets, flute, a grungy melody sound) -- He helped me immediately "plug in" HIS Words of Psalm 111 (the first psalm I looked at, too).

In TWENTY minutes. It took 1/2 hour to figure out and write into the music sheet some of those chord ideas God had given me to add to JohnnyK's grungy rock riffs!
