Psalm 114: 7 TREMBLE, O earth, at the presence of the Lord, At the presence of the God of Jacob, 8 Who turned the rock into a pool of water, The flint into a fountain of waters.

Verse 8 of Psalm 114 shows why YHWH God punished Moses for disobedience, HITTING the rock on the 2nd occasion, instead of just speaking – Numbers 20:11 – BECAUSE DOUBTERS then could say it was NOT YHWH but *human* action that brought water. God says exactly that in the next verse: By HITTING rock, **Moses did not show it was GOD who was the Holy Miracle worker & SAVIOR.**

CHORUS

Rejoice people! – ye who truly love and trust The LORD!
Choose to **leave your Egypt** and return to your God! He'll free
you..... **NOW!!**
Psalm One-Fourteen..... leave... EGYPT!

BRIDGE

Exodus 7 – God declared freedom for
leaving your Egypt to go serve JUST Him.
Exodus 8, TWICE – God declared **freedom** for
leaving your Egypt to go serve JUST Him.
Exodus 9, TWICE - God declared **freedom** for
leaving your Egypt to go serve JUST Him.
Exodus 10 and **still:**
God declareS freedom for **leaving your Egypt to go serve JUST Him.**

Verse 1

The sea fled at its Great Creator's command: Saved His people!
The Red Sea rolled back and turned into dry land: God saves people!

Repeat CHORUS (after long introduction music) – **no bridge**

Verse 2:

Mountains skip like earthquakes at the LORD's command: See His Glory!
Little hills roll up like mountains to the sky: Tremble people!

Reading 1: “The Power of God in His Deliverance of Israel -

See the full history in Exodus 14: 1–31

PSALM 114, 1 and 2

- 1 When Israel went out of Egypt,
The house of Jacob from a people of *strange* language,
- 2 Judah became His* sanctuary, [* *the LORD YHWH Jehovah God's*]
And Israel, His dominion.** ” [** *over which God was LORD*].

CHORUS, then Verse 3:

God turned rock into fountains of fresh waters: for His people.
Guided and provided escape from Egypt --- GOD CAN FREE US!

Reading 2 after verse 3:

PSALM 114, verses 1 thru 4:

- 1 When Israel went out of Egypt,
The house of Jacob from a people of strange language,
- 2 Judah became His sanctuary, And Israel, His dominion.
- 3 The sea saw it and fled; Jordan [*River*] turned back.
- 4 The mountains skipped like rams, The little hills like lambs.

Repeat CHORUS – NO BRIDGE

Reading at end:

during the music of Bridge

PSALM 114, starting at verse 5:

- 5 What ails you, O sea, that you fled? O Jordan, that you turned back?
- 6 O mountains, that you skipped like rams? O little hills, like lambs?
- 7 TREMBLE, O earth, at the presence of the Lord,
At the presence of the God of Jacob,
- 8 Who turned the rock into a pool of water, The flint into a fountain of waters.

Song Story: The music began as a Psalm 119 section song, but I selected a different style and just saved this project as “*untitled D minor*”. Later I was looking for music to these lyrics, already formed into verses and a chorus--- and God guided me to this one where the notes fit the mood perfectly!

As to where the rest of the music ideas came from: Once again my only explanation is: From the Holy Spirit's guidance. I sat down at my workstation keyboard and “just played” the basics... and the ideas for all the other tracks just came. Including to find and re-use my studio producer's live drums track, played for PET HEAVEN -- which just happened, in God's way, to be exactly the right tempo (out of about 80 common possibilities!) and style to fit this song! We recorded the song and put it on the World Wide Web 3 days after I started the music. It's God's! -DD:)
