### THEME of the entire Psalm 119 that LORD God led David to write for Him:

“The ENTIRETY of Your Word is TRUTH, and EVERY one of Your righteous judgments  
ENDURES forever.” *Psalm 119: 160*. God says the same thru  
2nd Timothy 3:16. God says same thru all verses having the phrase “Statutes FOREVER”.

## CHORUS

God's entire Word is Truth: Psalm 119: One-Five-Three, RESH, “Head”.  
God's ev'ry judgment is righteous, should LEAD us, Leading forever.  
Jesus repeats Matthew 5:18: Psalm 119: One-Five-Three RESH Truth:  
God's testimonies and precepts shall endure while Earth does-- Leading us: RESH.

## VERSES

1

LORD, please think on my affliction, for I don't forget Your Law.  
Revive me, as Your Word promised. Redeem me. Plead my cause.  
The wicked won't see salvation while they won't seek God's Statutes. For >> **Bridge**

Great are the LORD's tender mercies. Though people come against me.  
I'm disgusted by their sinning treachery. They won't keep Your Word--  
God's Bible Word Testimonies – and they won't keep God's Word. Though >> **Bridge**

3

LORD, please think on how so deeply I've grown to love Your precepts.  
Revive me, as Your Word promised. I know Your entire Word endures.  
Though some with pride know You're loving, they SAY Grace replaced God's Law Words.

**BRIDGE** between each verse, and back to **CHORUS** after Verse 3

God's entire Word is Truth. Through God's precepts come JOY an LIFE.  
Lovingkindness of LORD God revives all who trust the Word of God.

**Song Story.** Original title was for section 153 RESH ENDURING. Then I did some research on this Hebrew letter of the alphabet (or, aleph bet)... Thru the Bible, God uses a lot of patterns and repetitive symbols including numbers and repeats.

RESH comes from the very common word ראש (*rosh*) basically means **HEAD**, but is used to indicate what-ever LEADS or comes first: Captain, Summit, Cap stone of an arch. JESUS is corner-stone (Psalm 118:22, Matthew 21:42), our Captain (Hebrews 2:10 WEB). **Our RESH LEADER.**
