**Scriptures: First Corinthians 15, “The RESURRECTION” Chapter “Our Final Victory”**  
 50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; *nor does corruption inherit incorruption.* 51 Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—  
 52 **in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye**, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. 53 For this corruptible must put on **incorruption**, and this mortal must put on **immortality**. 54 *So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality,* then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written:  
**“Death is swallowed up in victory.”** [God's **Promise** thru Isaiah 25: 8 ]  
 55 “O Death, where is your sting? [God's **Promise** thru Hosea 13:14 ]  
 O Hades, where is your victory?”  
 56 The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law.  
 57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.  
 58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable,  
**always abounding in the work of the Lord,**  
**knowing that your labor is not in vain *in the Lord.***  
 First Corinthians 15, The Resurrection Chapter – Our Final Victory with the LORD  
 who **AWAKENS US to LIFE**.... as He **promised** through Psalm 139.
