HALLELUJAH: This is a compound word. 1st half: The Hebrew word **Hallah** is a COMMAND (imperative) FOR ALL people (plural) verb. 2nd half: YAH is God's Name, shown in Exodus 3:14; Latin used the letter J instead of Y (for example, Jehovah is a Latinized word for same name YHWH in Exoddu 3:14). BUT "hallelujah" means MORE than simply "praise Yah". **Hallel** means a JOYOUS praise in song, to BOAST in God (= "EL"). *Psalm 34:2, "The humble shall hear of it and be glad."*

* Exodus 3:14, The LORD God tells us His Name is YHWH, often spelled out as Yahweh, and usually pronounced "YAW-WAY". It is Hebrew for "I AM".... "I AM, Exist, Who I AM".
