* Exodus 3:14, The LORD God tells us His Name is **YHWH**, often spelled out as Yahweh, and usually pronounced "YAW-WAY".

CHORUS "a"

VERSE 1

The voice of The LORD is over the waters. The God of Glory thunders. The LORD is over many waters. The voice of The LORD is powerful.

VERSE 2

The voice of The LORD is full of Majesty. The voice of The LORD breaks great cedar trees! YES, He splinters cedars, they skip like a calf! The voice of The LORD even divides flames!

INTERLUDE

Ev'ryone shout "GLORY!" "GLORY to The LORD!" The King Forever sits on His throne! **Psalm 29, God voicing** His Word.

TRANSITION TO HIGHER KEY FOR REST OF SONG

CHORUS "b"

Give to The LORD, Give to The LORD Worship The LORD Give Him THE Glory Psalm 29, VOICE praise to Yahweh*! Psalm 29, hear His VOICE and obey!

VERSE 3

The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness. Through his'try, The LORD HAS shaken wildernesses. At His voice, enthroned Back, at the FLOOD, through At His voice, forests can be stripped bare.

VERSE 4

Yahweh* sat entrhone Back, at the FLOOD, through his'try The LORD HAS been KING on His Throne. The LORD gives strength to His people. He blesses all who Name Him their God and LORD.

POSTLUDE

Scriptures - Psalm 29

- 1 Give unto the LORD, O you mighty ones, Give unto the LORD glory and strength.
- 2 Give unto the LORD the glory due to His name; Worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.
- 3 The voice of the LORD is over the waters; The God of glory thunders; The LORD is over many waters.
- 4 The voice of the LORD is powerful; The voice of the LORD is full of majesty.
- 5 The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars, Yes, the LORD splinters the cedars of Lebanon.
- 6 He makes them also skip like a calf, Lebanon and Sirion like a young wild ox.
- 7 The voice of the LORD divides the flames of fire.
- 8 The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness; The LORD shakes the Wilderness of Kadesh.
- 9 The voice of the LORD makes the deer give birth, And strips the forests bare; And in His temple everyone says, "Glory!"
- 10 The LORD **sat enthroned at the Flood**, And the LORD sits as King forever.
- 11 The LORD will give strength to His people; The LORD will bless His people with peace.

Additional fascinating scriptures about God's VOICE that HE inspired to be in His Word

(2nd Timothy 3:16, ALL scripture is inspired by the LORD... and, of course as THE Creator, He certainly has power to ensure that His Bible has words that we can have faith that He will answer prayers for wisdom as we study... John 14:26 (Jesus's promise), James 1:5 (God's promise through James).

DEUTERONOMY 4 (Beginning with Deuteronomy 1:1, These are the words which Moses spoke to all Israel on this side of the Jordan in the wilderness):

33 "Did *any* people *ever* hear the voice of God speaking out of the midst of the fire, as you have heard, and live? 34 Or did God ever try to go and take for Himself a nation from the midst of another nation, by trials, by signs, by wonders, by war, by a mighty hand and an outstretched arm, and by great terrors, according to all that the LORD your God did for you in Egypt before your eyes? 35 To you it was shown, that you might know that the LORD Himself is God; there is none other besides Him. 36 **Out of heaven He let you hear His voice, that He might instruct you**; on earth He showed you His great fire, and you heard His words out of the midst of the fire."

NUMBERS 14 (a warning that even when God pardons sin, there are Consequences to those who refuse to heed His VOICE.... and rewards to those like Caleb who honor Him.) MOSES to YHWH God: 19 Pardon the iniquity of this people, I pray, according to the greatness of Your mercy, just as You have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now." 20 Then the LORD said: "I have pardoned, according to your word; 21 but truly, as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the LORD— 22 because all these men who have seen My glory and the signs which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have put Me to the test now these ten times, and **have not heeded My voice**, 23 they certainly shall not see the land of which I swore to their fathers, nor shall any of those who rejected Me see it. 24 But My servant Caleb, because he has a different spirit in him & has followed Me fully, I will bring into the land where he went, & his descendants shall inherit it.

Matthew 3:17, when Jesus was being baptized: 'And suddenly a **Voice** came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." ' (repeated in Matthew 17:5 and Mark 9:7 at a much later time).

John 10: 3-4, "To him the doorkeeper opens, and **the sheep hear his voice**; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his **voice**."

John 10: 9, 16: Jesus telling of being the Good Shepherd to not only God's people of Israel but also to others "not of that flock", that is, of Gentiles per many prophecies: " "I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and <u>they will hear My voice</u>; and there will be one flock *and* one shepherd."

Song Story. I had sketched out some lyrics to this psalm in 2011. It took almost 6 full years before I completed this Lyrics set.... but by then, the LORD has helped me to become much more skilled in CRAFTING the psalms He inspired to David into formats that can be set to music and sung as worship hymns to Him in a modern setting.... What He "does with this" is His business.... but I'm joyfully thanking The LORD for the fun of serving Him with songs that

help people learn the words of His Bible scriptures! - DdO:)
