Song Story: THE MUSIC. The music was really easy to create at the keyboard. It took longer to write out the notes. Especially for that chord marked "D [keyboard: E F# A C]"..... I STILL have no idea what that chord idea from God is named! What took longest, though, was figuring out a fast joyful pace that would give time for singers to fit in all of Psalmist David's Words. I think that, with God's empowering, this psalm of His praise came out to be a song that's really fun to sing!

Song Story: THE LYRICS. The repeated, yet never boring, song story is this: I sat down with my New KJV Bible and special Psalm journal with a prayer for God's guidance in putting another of His Psalms-through-David into modern music. turned to Psalm 33, and the lines just fell into place.
