JOHN 10:10, Jesus described Satan as a speaker of charming, but EVIL, words:
Full of HATE for all who truly love the LORD. Jesus said he seeks to destroy you--
but JESUS came to bring LIFE-- and not just any life, but life **ABUNDANT!**

VERSES 1 & 5 (Movements 1 & 3)

Charm..... ing,..... ever sweetly
slith-..... ering charm,
skilled voice, so deceiving – drips like Poison.
God warns repeatedly: Psalm 58: Don't be deceived,
Satan puts thoughts in your head like
PRETTY COBRAs, wicked, DEADLY.
spitting words of "love" though they HATE you!
John 10: Verse 10: Satan HATES you!
John 8: 44, Satan puts LIES in your mind.

VERSES 2, 3, & 5 (Movement 2)

- 2 Do you indeed speak righteousness, you selfish ones?
NO! In your heart, you work wickedness – violent with "*Smiles ... On*".
Like a DEAF COBRA, you refuse to hear God's Truth.... So you
spread your poison..... ever "charming".

TAG:

PSALM 58: Words of that Snake still go charming on.
James 4:8, Run toward Go! Ask His Wisdom.... and He gives TRUTH!

- 3 LORD, break the FANGS of evil ones, with their lion's ... fangs.
FLUSH them away, with rushing fast waters. SAVE us from such villains!
Let them be like snails.... melting as they go, with words so "charming".
Let Your WHIRLWIND ... take them.... away. > **TAG**
- 4 In God's living, burning **Holy** wrath, He's LORD, judging ... Earth.
Thus....people will see for themselves that God judges "charming" LIES with TRUTH.
LORD help us who love You be protected from smooth words, so "charming".
Give us hearts that seek Your TRUTH. > **TAG, then Verse 5 (above)**
