**Psalm 7: 10 "My defense is of God,
Who saves the upright in heart...** 14 Behold, the wicked brings forth iniquity;
Yes, he conceives trouble and brings forth falsehood... 16 His trouble shall return upon his own head,
And his violent dealing shall come down on his own crown. ... 17 I will praise the LORD according to
His righteousness, And will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High." = **YHWH: Isaiah 42:8.**

***YHWH (Yahweh) = God's Name** that He shares in Isaiah 42:8 *HEBREW*, **it's NOT**
"LORD" here *or in about 6,000 other places where God's Name is*
mistranslated as His TITLE of LORD.

CHORUS at beginning & after each verse

This I pray, to You, LORD Yahweh* : Psalm 7 as I **face..... accusations.**
Save me from those who RIP at me like lions, with false accusations.
If I have done the wrong they say: I TRULY want to know, LORD God, Yahweh.
BUT JUST You do I TRUST to judge me. Save me! form Liars, & Gossip-mongers.

VERSE 1

LORD Yahweh, God, IF I have done what's said of me, YOU be the Judge,
I would deserve the evil they want. Psalm 7: 5, I pray to You, God.
I truly want You, Holy God, to judge me, whether I'm wrong or right.
My defense is of GOD who saves the Upright in Heart..... I CAN Trust YHWH.

VERSE 2

LORD Yahweh, God IS THE Just Judge. RIGHT-ly angered by wicked ones.
God sharpens His sword against evil ones-- Psalm 7: 11 -- sharpens arrows and
on their own heads returns evil **THEY** planned. God defends **ALL** who HONOR him.
My defense is Yahweh, Who saves the Upright in Heart..... We CAN Trust God.....!

Song Story. Lyrics set up in music format during a session on the gym elliptical machine, as I often do. Different this time: When I first asked God to help me form HIS psalms back into music back in 2009 especially prayers, I expected to start with Psalm 1 and go in numerical order. At the Moment, I don't remember which Psalm I wrote into music first.... but I had recorded about 105 psalms songs (remember there are 21 for Psalm 119!) by the time it suddenly dawned on me.... I had never yet written a melody and chords for **PSALM 1 BEING** which I formed into music in 2011. So, with God's help, I wrote that music on Sunday May 5, and recorded it on May 6th & put it on the World Wide Web.... And then, I started thinking about the next still *missing* song number -- **Psalm 7** :) I'd already done almost every other psalm up to the 40s, plus all the 90s and most 100s..... Wrote ALL music... melody & chords.... in one hour on May 14. Recorded tracks in 1 hour. On World Wide Web with vocals that night. **EPHESIANS 3: 20-21, only by God's empowering.**
