Nehemiah 9: 1 Now on the 24th day of this month the children of Israel were assembled with fasting, in sackcloth, and with dust on their heads. 2 ... they stood and confessed their sins and the iniquities of their fathers. 3 And they stood up in their place and read from the Book of the Law of the LORD their God *for 1/4th of the day*; and *for another fourth* they confessed and worshiped the LORD their God. Then *[the many priests]* ... said: "Stand up *and* bless the LORD your God Forever and ever! "Blessed be Your glorious name, Which is exalted above all blessing and praise! 6 You alone *are* the LORD; You have made heaven, The heaven of heavens, with all their host, The earth and everything on it, The seas and all that is in them, And You preserve them all. The host of heaven worships You." [And after speaking the history of the peoples, Nehemiah 9 concludes with the priests declaring to God,] "Nevertheless in Your great mercy You did not utterly consume them nor forsake them; For You *are* God, gracious and merciful."
