I look in my journals at song drafts when I'm ready to seek another to record, and I am always amazed at how few words are changed. When they are, it is usually to fit into the music that I later design.

But if I write out the music at the same time as the lyrics, seldom are there many changed words.

The music was amongst my hardest, because I can't "cheat" and use my home studio's program for quantizing notes in an odd timing like jazz or shuffles or this Latin beat. The computer would make all the timing very boringly even. So I literally had to edit note by note to get the timing right in all the odd timing measures.

And then this song probably took longer to learn than 98% of 'my' songs that God guides.... partly because I deliberately design easy-to-learn-and-worship melodies with some occasional notes thrown in for interest and fun challenge!

But, in doing this for God: It was a fun gift to do for Him.... in the empowering of HIS gifting of this music and the skills.
