 DON'T let those who despise You prevail, so the World
 will see God's Power rule this world! God's Mighty Work!
 God will judge nations! -- Psalm 9!

VERSES 5 and 6, same ragged beat

God blots out names of wicked ones FOREVER.

God destroys great cities of the wicked ones.

God prepares His Throne and shall judge the world rightly - He's Our Peace!

Nations will sink down into pits THEY have dug.

In their OWN traps, they are caught when they attack.

God's people will praise the Holy Name of God, singing with Psalm 9!
