Selah is used 74 times in the Hebrew Bible— 71 times in the Psalms & 3 times in Habakkuk. Of the psalms in which it is found, 23 belong to the group where the Plural-as-One word **Elohim** is the Name used to designate God, whose Name is YHWH / Yahweh (see Exodus 3:14). Whether SELAH is a musical term like "Interlude" used before the next set of words, or another meaning is unknown. This IS certain: Wherever SELAH occurs is a good time to STOP and REST... to PRAY to God privately.... to pause for time with the LORD YHWH God and rest in Him: Psalm 46: 10-11, **BE STILL AND KNOW THAT I AM GOD.**

The LORD of hosts *is* with us; The God of Jacob *is* our refuge. Selah

Matthew 11:28, ""Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. ". And in John 14:17: "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid."

AFTER VERSE 5 - SALVATION

Psalm 25: 1-5. "To You, O LORD, I lift up my soul. O my God, I trust in You; Let me not be ashamed; Let not my enemies triumph over me. Indeed, let no one who waits on You be ashamed; Let those be ashamed who deal treacherously without cause. Show me Your ways, O LORD; Teach me Your paths. Lead me in Your truth and teach me, for You are the God of my salvation; On You I wait all the day."

AFTER VERSE 6 - SALVATION FROM DEATH

Psalm 68: 19-20. "Blessed be the Lord, Who daily loads us with benefits, The God of our salvation! SELAH. Our God is the God of salvation; And to GOD the Lord belong escapes from death."

END: Jesus offers SELAH:

John 16:33. "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you WILL have tribulation; BE of good cheer, I have overcome the world."
