SPOKEN after Part 3:

First John 4, verses 9 and 10 tell some of God's Valentine words to you: "God showed how much He loved us by sending his only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. This is real love. It is NOT that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins" - First John 4: 9-10 New Living Translation

Now the question is: What will be your valentine to Him? He asks for you to trust HIS love enough to give Him YOUR ALL as your valentine.
