Song Story. This was another fast AND fun song from God's Holy Spirit! I myself love hot weather, so all winter long, I respond to people complaining about the winter cold that they'll be complaining about the heat in a few months. And I really do believe God has a sense of humor about how we complain no matter what the weather. HOWEVER, the Old Testament makes it quite clear: **God does NOT find it amusing when we keep complaining about Him with His deep love for us.** Jesus references this in John 3:14 right --before our favorite verse 16. People complained so much to God that God finally sent snakes to give them a good reason to complain (see Numbers 21). Death came if they did not set aside pride and obey God by turning to the solution to death that He provided. In our case: turning to Jesus Whom God lifted up on the cross to save all who look upon Him in faith. See Numbers 11... complaints against God weren't new.
