Song Story. The song was written in moments at the altar though the pattern developed as I searched for "heavenly" guitar chords while looking up from under God's huge trees one warm February afternoon. Concept: We blithely, unthinkingly let John 3:16 roll of our tongues if we've heard it a lot, many of us can quote it while thinking about what we'd like to go get for lunch. I'd been praying for a song especially to help people who don't think they're "worthy" of God to realize that God chooses them anyway. (Not one of us is "worthy" of God.)

I'd also been doing a lot of Old Testament studies along with James 2:5 and Romans 11, which show that indeed, God chooses all. As Second Peter 3:9 says, God wants ALL people to be saved. And thus these simple song words "just came" to me as I thought of the amazement that God -- Who Created All -- loved and chose us even before we knew He exists (First John 4: 9-10).
