Long before it was popular in "regular churches", my Dad followed Jesus's way of telling people about God and His Bible a LOT with "parables". Most he made up. Some were from "Bird Life In Wington" old children's book by John Calvin Reid. The rest were from the ONE published Parable book >> THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO PEANUTS... about Snoopy & Charlie Brown &tc... NOW>>

NOW?? There's also a "Gospel According to Star Trek:The Original Crew" book.

It wasn't YET written back when I showed DVD excerpts of MANY episodes to teach "parables" to the high school kids for a decade.... My favorite = "**The Next Generation**, Season 2----which I used EVERY Christmas: "**THE CHILD**"- -->

Crewman Deanna learns she's suddenly pregnant. YES -- Is pregnant Suddenly. And within a couple of days she HAS a healthy tiny baby boy. A few days later-- he looks like his is about "8 earth years". OTHER people on the Enterprise are wary ... suspicious. What does Deanna do???

She teaches about Puppies & Joy, Friendships & how Beauty makes us feel. He chooses to leave - "DIES" - because something about him is making the Enterprise about to explode. (Good choice, ehhh?) But-- **KEY POINT**---->

THE CHILD's **real** Self leaves that child body as a Light ball.
Deanna asks WHY he as an obviously a very advanced alien came. He replies:

He had been able to **SEE** what the people on the ship DID,
but wanted to **FEEL** what they did -- Which is why he also deliberately touched something VERY hot and was badly burned. Until then, he had seen how people had Pain but never felt it.

THIS IS A GREAT PARABLE.... The famous Sci-Fi creator of the Star Trek series included MANY episodes that reflected scriptures, and subsequent writers followed Gene Roddenberry's pattern at times**.

"THE CHILD" does VERY much describes a major goal of Jesus when He came along with fulfilling God's ISAIAH 43 comfort that Only He is Our Savior.... and that He would COME TO DWELL AMONG US -- as Prophesied 100s of years before Jesus, incl. in Zechariah 2:10-11 and 8:3, --- spelled out in the Gospel of John 1: 14..... "To dwell Among Us"...

Hebrews 4:15 summarizes what "The Child" illustrated -->

Jesus is our High Priest (Savior from Sins) and yet He CAN
from His own experience as a Human SYMPATHIZE with us people....

- (1) Emotionally, Jesus OBVIOUSLY felt pain when even close friends abandoned Him....
- (2) Physically, Jesus OBVIOUSLY felt pain in his 39 whippings and upon the Cross...
- (3) Spiritually, Jesus was tempted to ignore God's Truth and commandments, and tempted to even wonder if God cared-- as Satan repeatedly does to us humans....

Hebrews 4:15 summarizes, (QUOTE) Jesus was "tempted in every way, just as we are— yet he did not sin".

Jesus UNDERSTANDS the feelings that sometimes **swamp** us... the many types of **pain**....
Because He Came to Dwell Among us AS one of us, in a human body.....

Like that fascinating Sci Fi alien in Star Trek's THE CHILD did.

8 *God named YHWH (Isaiah 42:8 Hebrew) COMFORTS US thus >*
 "Be still, and *KNOW* that I am God."

Watching (yet again) Charles Stanley's video online of "A Time For Courage" (at InTouch.org).... He comforts with this definition: Even though our Lord says FEAR NOT, that doesn't mean that He does not UNDERSTAND when we hit those situations where we FEEL fear... It's not a sin to FEEL fear -- but to LET Anxiety take control. Doubts in God, frustrations that He doesn't seem to answer prayers.

Focused on the fears >>> When God promises THIS COMFORT:

Run FROM those (James 4:7) and Run TO (To, to) HIM! (4:8).

What happens then? 4:8 continues --

God will HIMSELF RUN TO you and me -- Like the Prodigal Son's father racing toward his wayward son as soon as he saw the son returning.

And KEEP A JOURNAL or formal (easy to find) notebook that describes ALL THE TIMES that God has ALREADY helped you thru something..... So that you can remember: God has been Faithful before AND will AGAIN -- because He never changes -- Malachi 3:6 + Hebrews 13:8.

Charles Stanley defines Courage: Being bold and facing life DESPITE. That phrase as a prayer = One of my favorite of God's earliest songs thru me was one of His first 10 (2008). "I Praise You Despite All The Troubles I See".... Scriptures >>

Psalm 71: 14, "But I will hope continually, And will praise You yet more and more." – Psalm 71: 5 and 11 was, ""WHY are you cast down, O my soul? And WHY are you disquieted within me? Hope in God, for I shall yet praise Him for the help of His countenance." – verses 5 & 11

Psalm 46: 1 RSV: "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble."

but whoever **DOES AND TEACHES** *them*, he shall be called **GREAT** in the kingdom of Heaven.
