The Ark Placed in the Tabernacle    (2 Sam. 6:17–19)  
Compare verses 23–33 with **Psalm 96:1–13**  
Compare verses 35, 36 with **Psalm 106:47, 48**

23 Sing to the LORD, all the earth;                      Verse 1b  
    Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day.

24 Declare His glory among the nations,              Verse 1c  
    His wonders among all peoples.

25 For the LORD *is* great and greatly to be praised;      Verse 1d  
    He *is* also to be feared above all gods.

26 For all the gods of the peoples *are* idols,              Verse 1e
