Psalm 42: 13-15. "Those who are planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God. They shall still bear fruit in old age; They shall be fresh and flourishing,"

SPOKEN WORDS 2

AFTER Verse 4 (before chorus)

God made His promises in Isaiah 41 to His people of Israel - Jews- who follow Him.

Through Isaiah 66 and Romans 11, God's promises are also for Gentiles who choose to be Grafted In and also follow and honor Him:

Isaiah 41:10. "Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.

Isaiah 40: 31. "Those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."

Psalm 92: 12-15. "The righteous shall flourish like a palm tree, He shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. 13 Those who are planted in the house of the LORD Shall flourish in the courts of our God. 14 They shall still bear fruit in old age; They shall be fresh and flourishing, 15 To declare that the LORD is upright; He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him."

SPOKEN WORDS 3

AFTER Chorus Referenced in TAG 1 and 2:

Sometimes as we pray, we pray Psalm 42:11. "Why are you cast down, O my soul? Why are you disquieted within me? **Hope in God;** For I shall yet praise Him ----- The Help of my countenance, and my God."

Isaiah 46: 3-4 gives promises of God to those who are approaching the Winter Age of their Life. YHWH GOD says to ALL who HONOR Him as LORD >>> "You have been upheld by Me from birth. I've carried you from the womb. "EVEN TO your old age, **I AM** He. **And even to gray hairs I will carry you! I have made you, and I will bear; Even ****I** will carry, and will deliver you!**"**

Second Corinthians 4 verses 7 to 9, and 14 through 18 in NEW LIVING TRANSLATION

7 We now have this light shining in our hearts, but we ourselves are like fragile clay jars containing this great treasure. This makes it clear that **our great power is from God, NOT from our selves.....** Our Power is from God-- NOT from Youthful strength. OUR POWER IS FROM GOD ----- **Even in the AGE OF OUR WINTER GLORY IN GOD.**
