READING: Yes, warn people. Yes, pray for them. But EVEN JESUS could not convince most people to listen to His Words of Life. The end of Matthew 23 shows Jesus even wept for them. In His parable of the Rich man and Lazarus, Jesus tells how the rich man YEARNS to warn his brothers who are still living.... Luke 16: (20 on), **“And being in torments in Hades,** he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.... “Then he said, ‘I beg you therefore, father, that you would send him to my father’s house, for I have five brothers, that he may testify to them, lest they also come to this place of torment.’ AND THE PROPHECY REPLY OF ABRAHAM: “But he said to him, ‘If they do not hear Moses & the prophets, **neither will they be persuaded though one rise from the dead.’”**
