"Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." -- Jesus

VERSE 2: **Psalm 4: 8** I will both lie down in peace, & sleep; For You alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety. **Psalm 29: 11** The LORD will give strength to His people; The LORD will bless His people with peace.

VERSE 3: **Psalm 119: 165**, Great peace have those who love Your law, & nothing causes them to stumble. **Psalm 85: 8** I will hear what God the LORD will speak, For He will speak peace to His people and to His saints; But let them not turn back to folly. **John 16:33**, JESUS: In the World, you will have tribulation. BUT be of Good Cheer: *I* have overcome the world!

MOVEMENT 2 YHWH = Name God says is His, Isaiah 42:8, Exodus 3:14-15. "Yaw-way" is spelled out as Yahweh (or Jehovah), replaced by LORD over 6,000 times in most Bibles.

READINGS after each verse (before MOVEMENT 2): WITH COMMENTARY WORDS:

VERSE 1: Jesus's parable of answered prayers EVEN IF OUR FAITH is as little as a Mustard Seed can give us PEACE: **Keep your faith in the LORD, & not in YOU**-- your "amount of faith".
John 14: 26-27. "But **the Helper, the Holy Spirit**, whom the Father will send in My name, He will **teach** you all things, & bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you. "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." -- Jesus

VERSE 2: Jesus clearly showed thru Mark 9:24 that He answers our prayers EVEN WHEN we have feelings of Doubt, like this man admitted as he asked Jesus, "Help my unbelief"-- and God healed his son. **Psalm 4: 8** I will both lie down in peace, & sleep; For You alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety. **Psalm 29: 11** The LORD will give strength to His people; The LORD will bless His people with peace.

VERSE 3: **Psalm 119: 165**, Great peace have those who love Your law, & nothing causes them to stumble. **Psalm 85: 8** I will hear what God the LORD will speak, For He will speak peace to His people and to His saints; But let them not turn back to folly. **John 16:33**, JESUS: "In the World, you will have tribulation. BUT be of Good Cheer: *I* have overcome the world!" **FIND REAL PEACE** but trusting in JESUS -- and not in your own ability to stop feelings of doubt. After all: By definition, Temptation is Satan putting thoughts in your head (as he did to Jesus about turning rocks to bread): **So just ignore Doubts about God's FAITHFULNESS** that **ALWAYS** keeps His promises... Like giving **PEACE** to all who **Honor** Him.
