“<sup>11</sup> Not that I speak in regard to need, for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content: <sup>12</sup> I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. <sup>13</sup> **I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.** <sup>14</sup> Nevertheless you have done well that you shared in my distress. <sup>15</sup> Now you Philippians know also that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, **no church shared with me concerning giving and receiving but you only.** <sup>16</sup> For even in Thessalonica you sent aid once and again for my necessities. <sup>17</sup> Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that abounds to your account. <sup>18</sup> Indeed I have all and abound. I am full...<sup>19</sup> And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. <sup>20</sup> Now to our God and Father [be] glory forever and ever. Amen.” -- *Philippians 4: 11 to 20. NKJV.*

*Most people memorize verses 11-13 for their own reasons. However notice--- God calls us to **support the men and women who share His Gospel through the world...** and only one Church was sharing with Paul to pay for his living expenses as he preached at this time. YET-- like George Muller centuries later-- Paul did not complain. He did not beg other churches, though 2nd Corinthians 9 reminds that sharing with God's kingdom reaps blessings.*
