Prelude READING 1: In John 14, Jesus promised the Holy Spirit would come to us, to help us-- to pray. He did-- and Romans 8:26 promises that God's Spirit Himself prays FOR us, that Yahweh God will help us-- even when our hearts feel "Cold" -- He helps us become Warm.

READING 2, after Verse 1: **PSALM 73 a Cold yet Warm PRAYER**, verses 21-24

"Thus my heart was grieved, and I was vexed in my mind. I was so foolish and ignorant; **I was like a beast before You.** Nevertheless I am continually with You; You hold me by my right hand. You WILL guide me with Your counsel, and afterward receive me to glory."

READING 3, After Verse 2: **PSALM 73 my Cold yet Warm PRAYER**, verses 25-28: " Whom have I in heaven but You, LORD? And there is none upon earth that I desire besides You. My flesh and my heart fail; But God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.... 28 But it is good for me to draw near to God; I have put my trust in the Lord GOD, **THAT I MAY DECLARE ALL YOUR WORKS.** "

READING 4, At End: Psalm 73: 28, "It is GOOD for me to draw near to God!"
