VERSE 1

Each careless, idle word we speak, ev'ry idle word -- We will
Hear again at God's Judgement. Matthew 12 WARNS each of us.

SPOKEN WORDS 1

In Matthew 12: 36 and 37 Jesus warned firmly:

For every idle word we speak, we **will give account of it** in the Day of Judgment.
For by our words we will be justified ----- OR condemned.” — *New KJV*

BRIDGE

By idle words we will be condemned. We'll give Account for each word we said.
This, Jesus warned US in Matthew 12. Like Exodus 20 -- Don't mock God's Name!
God said again -- Chapter 4, Ephesians.

SPOKEN WORDS 2

Ephesians 4: 29 to 31. "NO foul language is to come from your mouth, but only what is good for building someone up ... ALL bitterness, anger & wrath, shouting & slander must be removed from you, along with all malice."

VERSE 2

CURSE words are NOT all that God has called "idle": Also
God's Name that we change to "Gosh" or "Golly" defame God's Name!

VERSE 3

Words God calls wrong are not just words of Damnation. Do NOT
Think God ignores "Hell" and "Damn": Words that mock God's TRUTH of HELL.

VERSE 4

It's not just bad habits to speak such idle words: God says
Ask Him for His help to stop speaking idle words He HATES.
(BRIDGE)

SPOKEN WORDS 3

In Exodus 20: 7, God Himself demands: "Do **NOT** misuse the name of the LORD your God.
The LORD YHWH will **NOT** leave anyone unpunished who mis-uses His name."
Psalm 103:12, Book of First John Chapter 1, and Isaiah 55:7 all show--
God DOES FORGIVE, if we humbly ASK.

Matthew 12: 33 - 37

New Living Translation (NLT)

JESUS: 33 "A tree is identified by its fruit. If a tree is good, its fruit will be good. If a tree is bad, its fruit will be bad. 34 You brood of snakes! How could evil men like you speak what is good and right? For whatever is in your heart determines what you say. 35 A good person produces good things from the treasury of a good heart, and an evil person produces evil things from the treasury of an evil heart. 36 And I tell you this, you must give an account on judgment day for every idle word you speak. 37 **The words you say will either acquit you or condemn you.**"

Ephesians 4: 29 - 31

Holman Christian Standard Bible (HCSB).

No foul language is to come from your mouth, but only what is good for building up someone in need, so that it gives grace to those who hear. Don't grieve God's Holy Spirit. You were sealed by Him for the day of redemption. All bitterness, anger & wrath, shouting & **slander** must be **removed** from you, along with all malice.

Colossians 3: 8 *ESV*

But now you must put them all away: Anger, wrath, malice, **slander**, and **obscene talk** from your mouth.

Exodus 20:7 *NKJV.*

"You shall **NOT** take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will **not** hold *him* guiltless, who takes His name in vain."

Isaiah 42: 6, 8 in Hebrew: **God clearly says "My Name is YHWH"..... often spelled "Yahweh"**

and pronounced "yaw-way" **but it is NOT "LORD"**. *That's* God's **TITLE**.

Ephesians 5:4 *ESV*

Let there be no filthiness nor foolish talk **nor crude joking**, which are out of place, but instead let there be thanksgiving.

James 1: 26 *ESV*

If anyone thinks he is religious and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his heart, this person's religion is worthless.

James 5:12
