Reading 1 Before Vs 1 + BR: Lamentations 3: 20-22. (New Living Translation, all)

20 I will never forget this awful time, as I grieve over my loss.as I grieve over my loss.
 21 Yet I still dare to hope when I remember this:
 22 The faithful love of the LORD never ends! His mercies never cease.

Reading 2 After Vs 1 + BR: Psalm 5:3. Listen to my voice in the morning, LORD, YHWH*. Each morning I bring my requests to You and wait **expectantly**.

Reading 3 After Vs 2 + BR: Psalm 59: 16-17 I will sing about Your power. Each morning I will sing with joy about Your unfailing love. For you have been my refuge, a place of safety when I am in distress. O my **Strength**, to You I sing praises, for You, O God, are my refuge, the God who shows me unfailing love.

Reading 4 After Vs 3 + BR: Lamentations 3: 23-26.

23 Great is His faithfulness; His mercies begin afresh each morning.
 24 I say to myself, "The LORD YHWH* is my inheritance; therefore, I will hope in Him!"
 25 The LORD is good to those who depend on Him, to those who search for Him.
 26 So it is good to wait quietly for salvation from the LORD.

* YHWH (pronounce "yaw-Way") = God's Hebrew Name that He gave-- not His Title of "LORD" ... see Isaiah 42:8
