READINGS

During PRELUDE:

NKJV for all

Through **Isaiah 46: 3b, 4, and 9** **GOD** named **YHWH** says:

You "have been upheld *by Me* from birth, who have been carried from the womb. Even to *your* old age, **I AM** He, And even to gray hairs I will carry *you!* I have made, and I will bear; Even I will carry, and will deliver you.... Remember the former things of old, for **I AM** God, and **there is no other; I AM God, and there is none like Me."**

At END OF SONG: In **Isaiah 42:8**, God **GIVES** His Name: Y-H-W-H pronounced "Yahweh" (yaw-Way) -- mis-translated as His **TITLE** of "LORD". In **Psalm 92: 13 to 15**, God inspired this **PRAYER: Psalm 92: 13 -15.**

- 1 *It is good to give thanks to the LORD, And to sing praises to Your name, O Most High;*
 - 2 *To declare Your lovingkindness in the morning, And Your faithfulness every night. The righteous shall flourish like a palm tree, He shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon.*

13 Those who are planted in the house of the **LORD YHWH** shall flourish in the courts of our God. **14 THEY SHALL STILL BEAR FRUIT IN OLD AGE;** They shall be fresh and flourishing, **15** To declare that the **LORD God YHWH** is upright; **He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.**

Psalm 91: 2. *1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. 2 I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust."* ...

Psalm 91 continued: "Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name. 15 He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him. 16 With long life I will satisfy him, **And show him My salvation."**
