READINGS

During PRELUDE: NKJV for all

Through Isaiah 46: 3b, 4, and 9 GOD named YHWH says:

You "have been upheld by Me from birth, who have been carried from the womb. Even to your old age, I AM He, And even to gray hairs I will carry you! I have made, and I will bear; Even I will carry, and will deliver you.... Remember the former things of old, for I AM God, and there is no other; I AM God, and there is none like Me."

<u>At END OF SONG:</u> In Isaiah 42:8, God GIVES His Name: Y-H-W-H pronounced "Yahweh" (yaw-Way) -- mis-translated as His TITLE of "LORD". In Psalm 92: 13 to 15, God inspired this PRAYER: **Psalm 92: 13 -15.**

- Those who are planted in the house of the LORD YHWH shall flourish in the courts of our God. 14 THEY SHALL STILL BEAR FRUIT IN OLD AGE;
 They shall be fresh and flourishing, 15 To declare that the LORD God YHWH is upright; He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.
