## **READING 2**

(after Verse 2's CHORUS)

• Exodus 33 is a chapter telling of much SORROW when people sin against HOLY GOD...

In a contrasting pattern ---

• **Jeremiah 33** is a chapter telling of much **JOY** for ALL people who grieve for sins and RETURN to <u>obeying</u> and loving holy God Named YHWH -- a prophecy for His people of Israel, and a promise for GRAFTED IN people, the Gentiles who honor YHWH and repent of their sins, as Romans 11 describes

#### **READING 3**

(after Verse 2's CHORUS)

In JEREMIAH 33, God is speaking through His prophet messenger: 6 Behold, I will bring it health and healing;

- I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth.
- And I will cause the captives of Judah and the captives of Israel to return, and will rebuild those places as at the first.
- I will cleanse them from all their iniquity by which they have sinned against Me, and I will pardon all their iniquities by which they have transgressed against Me.
- Then it shall be to Me a name of joy, a praise, and an honor before all nations of the earth, who shall hear all the good that I do to them; they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and all the prosperity that I provide for it.'

### **READING 4**

(at end)

Psalm 16: 9 to 11

"Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices; My flesh also will rest in hope.

10 For **You will not leave my soul in Sheol**, Nor will You allow Your holy one to see corruption. 11 You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures **forevermore**."

**Song Story** -- Inspired by a simple line in a sermon about Philippians 4:13, that "I can do all things through Christ, Who strengthens me."... **YES: It's true.**BUT like the **IF condition** in 2nd Chronicles 7:14 that is followed by an **IF NOT** statement that comes after —

**God is NOT** responsible for *blessing* or *protecting* or anything else for anyone who will NOT honor Him.

And Jesus defined **HOW** in John 15: It's simple: To obey The LORD God's commands. THAT is the only way He calls you a *FRIEND*. Jesus said so. John 15.
