Song Story. First John 4: 19. While visiting someone I dearly loved, she kept cleaning and cooking and cleaning more and continually asking me what I would like.... Her concern for me was very kind, but what I yearned for was to just sit and talk with her! That's the basic story of Luke 10: 38 to 42. God is of course pleased when we love Him and yearn to serve Him. But what God most wants is a close relationship with us. He began the relationship by loving us.... we continue it by, yes, being hospitable and serving Him at times, but also by Psalm 46:10 at times --- just being still and "with" God, listening to Him, being with Him. **As Jesus firmly told Martha to do.**
