IMPORTANT:

This song is NOT a criticism of churches but a reminder.... God calls us to gently shepherd people to Him. It is our calling to go share God's world (called "the great commission" in churches, though not given that name in Matthew 28 at the end). It is God's Holy Spirit's job to actually open people's eyes to Him, though. We can't "convert" anyone, and any appearance of "bull-dogging" simply drives people away from an openness to God.
