Often hymns - like this IMPORTANT! one - are published in an unnecessarily HARD KEY, or a harder-to-read timing like 6/8 with 1/16th notes or 3/2 with 1/8th notes. I change all to easier keys and timing – using OTEN, Osborne TExt Notation System..... THIS song was EASY craft into the OTEN method... But the ORIGINAL key in hymnals is usually either 3 or 6 FLATS, and lots of 1/16th notes in 6/8 time. Yes: Many of us easily play all the 1/16-th notes, but I worked to make it EASY for ALL. I Thank the Holy Spirit for *HIS* wisdom He gave me to invent this music method to help musicians at ALL levels to quickly play hymns & praise songs, & even to sketch out NEW songs for God on plain paper. – DianaDee Osborne
