SPOKEN WORDS 2

In Joshua 4, after God divided the Jordan River and His People of Israel walked on dry land to cross into His Promised land, God told the men to select 12 huge stones from the river bottom To take with them. God said these stones "are a sign among you. When your children ask in time to come, saying, 'What do these stones mean'?" then you shall answer: *They remind of us the time that God divided the Jordan River So that we could cross on dry land. These stones shall a memorial for Israel FOREVER.* There are many KINDS of Memory stones to Remind us of God -- and of what He did. Including Lists of God's Prayers answers that we read Over and Over.

CHORUS 2

God's Continuing Story.

Joshua 3: 9 So Joshua said to the children of Israel, "Come here, and hear the words of the LORD your God." 10 And Joshua said, "By this you shall know that the living God *is* among you, and *that* He will without fail drive out from before you [those who fight you]: 12 ... take for yourselves 12 men from the tribes of Israel, one man from every tribe. 13 ... AS SOON AS the soles of the feet of the priests who bear the ark of the LORD, the Lord of all the earth, shall REST IN THE WATERS of the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan shall be cut off <DIVIDED to make DRY LAND to WALK on>, the waters that come down from upstream, and they shall stand as a heap."

KEEP YOUR RIVER STONES CLOSE AS A SIGN TO REMEMBER:

Joshua 4: 1 And it came to pass, when all the people had completely crossed over the Jordan, that the LORD spoke to Joshua, saying: 2 "Take for yourselves twelve men from the people, one man from every tribe, 3 and command them, saying, 'Take for yourselves twelve stones from here, out of the <u>MIDST</u> of the Jordan, from the place where the priests' feet stood firm. You shall carry them over with you and leave them in the lodging place where you lodge tonight.'"

4 Then Joshua called the twelve men whom he had appointed from the children of Israel, one man from every tribe; 5 and Joshua said to them: "Cross over before the ark of the LORD your God into the midst of the Jordan, and each one of you **take up a stone on his SHOULDER < thus HEAVY**, *BIG*! >, according to the number of the tribes of the children of Israel, 6 <u>that this may be a sign</u> among you when your children ask in time to come, saying, 'What do these stones mean to you?' 7 Then you shall answer them that the waters of the Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the LORD; when it crossed over the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were stones shall be for a memorial to the children of Israel **FOREVER**."

Song Story.

I've been saving stones from music festivals and other special places.... plain old stones found on the ground plus a few specially bought crystal geodes, for years... Since long before I realized this story was in God's Bible of TWELVE STONES (early in Book of Joshua)..... Why? To remember happy times. Like driving 14 hours thru NC and TN mountains on trip to AL, talking with God all the way-- incl. at Cherokee camp ground in 2011.... and days of 24/7 fellowship with LORD God at music festivals.

AND To remember some of the scary things that God brought me through, including saving me from Day of TORNADOs two 2 days after Cherokee;.. and horrific storms that ALL of us were saved from – like that "Derecho" in Pennsylvania for the CREATION EAST music festival On the night of June 29-30, 2012.... The storm *literally* split and tornadic- fast winds raced on EACH side of the campground full of tents, poor shelter in a storm in the middle of farmlands. *NO* injuries or major damage despite about 20,000 people camped there....

STONES... God's reminders of all He HAS done, all He still WILL do when we who honor Him humbly ask.... JOURNALS of prayer answers give us comfort as we remember what we'd forgotten over the years – all God's Many Blessings. Keeping a record gives us a way to remember and THANK HIM AGAIN....... the REF note on page #1 shows that this song was written in my Journal Number 32 that started in year 2000....
