** NOTES:

- (1) VERSES are in 3/4 time after the 4/4 time CHORUS.
 - (2) YHWH is the name God gives for Himself in Isaiah 42:8 Hebrew. It is often spelled out as Yahweh and pronounced Yaw-way
 - (3) The Hebrew Descriptive title for God that is ADON rhymes with ALONE. It means LORD AND MASTER, and is the singular of the more common Title for LORD God that is used in praise songs, ADONAI.

READING 1, DURING PRELUDE

In Matthew 22 Jesus quoted to the Pharisees - religious leaders - Psalm 110 God's Word that speaks of Him. The religious leaders feared to answer His question, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?" They answered "The Son of David".

Jesus asked, "How then does David in the Spirit call Him Lord saying "The LORD said to my Lord 'Sit at My right hand till I make Your enemies Your footstool'?" Jesus continued with the question, "If David then calls Him Lord -- **HOW** is He his **SON**?" Matthew 22 after Jesus quoted Psalm 110 says "**None of them could answer Jesus a word. Nor from that day on did anyone dare question Jesus anymore.**"

CHORUS – in 4/4 time at beginning & optionally end

Jehovah, God Yahweh inspired what David said
in his prophecy of his lord and master, Christ.
Psalm one-hundred-ten, Messiah – David's kin.
Prophesied Messiah from David's future line.
God inspired David's psalm to prophesy Christ to come.
Jesus asked Pharisees what they thought David meant
in this prophecy of Him, Messiah THE Christ.
Psalm one-hundred-ten, Messiah – David's kin.
Matthew 22: 44, Jesus hinted, He Is LORD.
Jesus spoke scriptures that prophesied that He would come.

VERSE 4

*"Your people willingly follow and serve. The
LORD Yahweh swears He IS at Your right hand."*

David wrote more, with words from the LORD, of
Jesus, Messiah, Christ YET to be born.
Messiah, Christ, David's great- great- grandson's son's son!
NO one dared Question Jesus-- Psalm Hundred-Ten LORD.

READING 2, AT END OF SONG: Matthew 22 Verse 46, When Jesus quoted Psalm 110's prophecy of Himself, "No one was able to answer Him a word, nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore." YET, Instead the religious leaders hired **false witnesses** against Jesus.. Because they **UNDERSTOOD** Jesus **WAS** saying that HE was Messiah AND the **LORD** whom David prophesied.

CHORUS – in 4/4 time (OPTIONAL REPEAT at end)

From DianaDee:

This is rather funny, in a PSALM 2 way where God MOCKS people who think they're in control: Jesus stumped the Pharisees with HIS question about Psalm 110's prophecy... right after verse 15 – when **they** were plotting to try to figure out how to trick JESUS, when they "**plotted** how they might entangle Him in His talk." **INSTEAD:** They-- like licked bullies-- were the ones who had to slink away. God inspired these words: They did not dare to try to trick Jesus "from that day on".... Instead they turned to hiring false witnesses against Jesus... Religious leaders **UNDERSTOOD** Jesus **WAS** saying that HE was Messiah, the **LORD** of which David was writing.
