**READING 1, DURING PRELUDE:** In Matthew 22, JESUS speaks of **one PROPHECY** of HIMSELF- which religious leaders Feared to answer: 41 While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, saying, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?" They said to Him, "The Son of David." 43 He said to them, "**How then does David in the Spirit call Him 'Lord,'** saying: 44 'The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool"?' 45 If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his Son?" 46 And no one was able to answer Him a word, nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore. – Matthew 22.

**READING 2, AT END OF SONG: Matthew 22 Verse 46,** When Jesus quoted Psalm 110's prophecy of Himself, "No one was able to answer Him a word, nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore." YET, Instead the religious leaders hired **false witnesses** against Jesus.. Because they **UNDERSTOOD** Jesus **WAS** saying that HE was Messiah AND the **LORD** whom David prophesied.
