**READING 1, DURING PRELUDE:** In Matthew 22 Jesus quoted to the Pharisees - religious leaders - Psalm 110 God's Word that speaks of Him. The religious leaders feared to answer His question, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?" They answered "The Son of David".

Jesus asked, "How then does David in the Spirit call Him Lord saying "The LORD said to my Lord 'Sit at My right hand till I make Your enemies Your footstool'?" Jesus continued with the question, "If David then calls Him Lord -- **HOW is He his SON?**" Matthew 22 after Jesus quoted Psalm 110 says "None of them could answer Jesus a word. Nor from that day on did anyone dare question Jesus anymore."

**READING 2, AT END OF SONG: Matthew 22 Verse 46,** When Jesus quoted Psalm 110's prophecy of Himself, "No one was able to answer Him a word, nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore." YET, Instead the religious leaders hired false witnesses against Jesus.. Because they **UNDERSTOOD** Jesus **WAS** saying that HE was Messiah AND the **LORD** whom David prophesied.
