I made some minor changes such as changing several lines to be the repeated Bridge, but this is basically the same song that I did when I just "sat at the keyboard and played anything" at least five years earlier.... inspired by the Holy Spirit, Ephesians 3:20-21, for HIS Glory, for the Glory of God Named YHWH (Exodus 3:14-15, Isaiah 42:8), who keeps His promise to help ALL who honor Him when we face Troubles.
