**Song Story** Lyrics setup were written on Christmas Day... Intended as my gift to my LORD God in honor of Jesus's Birthday.... but the words fell into song pattern place so quickly that I realized yet again: This song is GOD's gift to me.... and, I pray, to you as an encouraging way to remember: God's promises of a resurrection to come are NOT just in what we call "the New testament".... John 15:9 JESUS: 9 "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love. 10 If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love."

John 8: 34 Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. 35 And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever. 36 Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.

John 11: 25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. 26 And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die.

**Do you believe this?**

Luke 6: 21-23 JESUS - "Blessed are you who hunger now, For you shall be filled. Blessed are you who weep now, For you shall laugh. 22 Blessed are you when men hate you, And when they exclude you, And revile you, and cast out your name as evil, For the Son of Man's sake. 23 Rejoice in that day and leap for joy! For indeed your reward is great **in heaven**, ....

First Corinthians 15: 50... flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption. 51 Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but **we shall all be changed— 52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet.** For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be **raised** incorruptible, and we shall be changed... "Death is swallowed up in victory." 55 "O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?" 56 The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law. 57 But thanks be to God, **who gives us the victory** through our Lord Jesus Christ.
